D5.2 – Some LOs for level 4

Knowledge

- a) Identify hazards with the potential to cause harm and/or loss
- b) Describe the risks associated with common occupational hazards
- c) Outline suitable techniques for assessing occupational risks
- d) Describe suitable methods to control risks









D5.2 – Some LOs for level 4

Skills

- a) Select appropriate methods for identifying hazards and evaluating risk
- b) Consider and prioritise where further risk controls are required
- c) Assist in the implementation of inspections and monitoring systems







D5.2 – Some LOs for level 4

Competences

- a) Prioritise those areas in workplaces where there is the most potential to cause harm
- b) Record significant findings
- c) Select suitable methods of keeping records relating to OHS
- d) Select sources of expert advice, guidance and information
