Submission of Abstracts and Papers

Please submit your abstract of up to 300 words and include up to 5 keywords on-line via EasyChair ([click here](#)). Abstracts will be sent to at least two referees. Only the authors of abstracts that pass this peer-review process will be invited to submit full papers. The deadline for the submission of abstracts is on the conference website. Full papers must not exceed 10 sides of A4.

Each paper will be reviewed by two members of the Scientific Committee. If the paper is accepted, its authors will be invited to present the paper at the conference. At least one of the authors must be able to attend the conference and present in person. Accepted papers will be published in proceedings with ISBN and DOI.

We are pleased to announce that the ICE Proceedings Journal of Management, Procurement and Law (a peer-reviewed international journal, please see www.icevirtuallibrary.com/toc/jmapl/current for more information) will publish a Conference Special Issue, guest edited by Dr Fred Sherratt and Prof Fidelis Emuze, with a selection of the best papers presented at the conference. The ICE MPL procedures will be followed for peer-review and for publication expected in 2024.
