The aim of the panel session is to discuss priorities and ways forward to promote successful partnerships between higher education and enterprises in the field of continuing training. The four panellists represent different stakeholders and institutions. The panel discussion will provide the opportunity to listen to their views and experiences.

I will open the panel session by presenting the topic and introducing the panellists. Each panellist will then have approximately 5 minutes to present his major views on:

What are key drivers / what needs to be done to promote partnerships for continuing training? Please name up to three priorities. Which concrete steps could be taken? You might also use examples to illustrate your points.

At some point, I will open the general discussion, where the audience (about 25 participants)

can intervene and you can also further develop your points. Ideally, the panel discussion will be a dynamic conversation. Other questions that might be addressed are, e.g.:

- Are higher education institutions prepared to enter the market of corporate and tailored continuing professional development programmes? Does this require structural changes and re-thinking at higher education institutions?
- Which experience with higher education – business cooperation for continuing training do you / your institution have?
- Take a look into the future: Which developments do you see for higher education – business cooperation in the next 5 years?
- Which key messages / new insights do you take home with you from the event? What have you learnt from the event? Was there anything that surprised you?

Please note that you do not need to bring any slides.
