Information about the Examination:

- The examination on Monday, November 28, will have 2 parts per **group**:
 - 10-15 minutes presentation of **homework**
 - 10-15 minutes discussion and oral interrogation
- We expect that you form **3 groups** for the "homework" part of the examination.
- Each group shall select a **topic** for the homework; this topic shall be
 - **either** QUALITY:
evaluation of an existing course (this can be a course you have participated in, or a course you know about from studying, or a course you found/find on the Internet, etc.) according to quality criteria
 - **or** DELIVERY:
work out a delivery concept (communication, interaction, learner support, media used for delivery, etc.) for one of the courses from the exercises from November 10 (Advanced Training Methods, Chinese for German native speakers, Behaviour manner [if none of these courses suits you, you may do that for another course, but you will in addition have to deal with the design/planning issues the same way as during the exercise])
- By Thursday, **November 24**, each group shall bring a **written concept** (max. 1 page), to contain:
 - names of all members of the group
 - topic selected (QUALITY or DISSEMINATION)
 - course used as example/demonstration
 - outline of the tasks you will perform til Monday
- Based on this written concept, we will (on Thursday) meet an **agreement** for the homework part for the examination.
- The **oral interrogation** part of the examination will relate the homework to the lecturers' presentations and check what you have learned from the presentations.
